



  - Worked with 10 Community Organizations to approve the following maps.





- Keeps Koreatown whole with Beverly Blvd as the northern boundary
- Contains whole Neighborhood Councils, splitting the PICO NC to keep the Jewish community together in an adjacent district and continuing the split of the Empowerment Congress West NC to keep Baldwin Hills and the Baldwin Hills-Crenshaw Plaza in CD 8, similar to the current configuration
- Keeps Little Ethiopia and Little Bangladesh whole in CD 10
- Economic assets include Koreatown, the Expo Line, the Crenshaw Corridor, Leimert Park, the Crenshaw Line, and the future Crenshaw North Line.
- North boundary Beverly Blvd; South Boundary Vernon Avenue; East Boundary Normandie Avenue to Western Avenue to Arlington Avenue; West Boundary – La Cienega Blvd
- Black CVAP is 33.05 percent



  - The \$1.7 Billion Crenshaw/LAX Line
  - The \$100 Million Destination Crenshaw Project
- North Boundary 10 Freeway; South Boundary The City boundary and Imperial Highway; East Boundary – Vermont Avenue, Normandie Avenue, the 110 Freeway, and the City boundary; West Boundary – the 405 Freeway
- Black CVAP stays above 50% at 50.94 percent



## CD9

- Keeps the same Neighborhood Councils whole in the District, while keeping portions of Empowerment Congress North NC and Empowerment Congress Southeast NC.
- CD9 has the highest level of poverty and the lowest income levels in the entire City, including some
  of the highest poverty census tracts in the State of California only District that truly needs
  economic assets
- Keeps Vermont Slauson whole in the District
- Maintains key economic assets USC, Expo Park, and the Convention Center/LA Live/Staples Center in CD 9
- Maintains continuity while the USC Specific Plan is being implemented, the Lucas Museum is being constructed, and the Convention Center is being rehabilitated.
- North Boundary Washington Blvd and LA Live; South Boundary Florence Avenue west of the 110 Freeway; East Boundary the City Boundary; West Boundary Normandie Avenue and Vermont Avenue
- Black CVAP is 25.01 percent; Maintains CD9 as a Latino Majority District at over 60% CVAP
